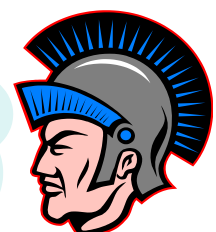

Final Performance

What to Bring to Camp

Bring extra socks The grass **will** be wet in the morning, and you will want dry socks later. It is very important to have dry socks in all rehearsals.

Sneakers. Sneakers and socks are worn to **ALL** marching rehearsal. No exceptions. Be aware that we will be painting our dots on the field. Be prepared for sneakers to get grass stained, dirt covered and paint sprayed.

Rain gear

Chart Book with plastic sheets for music and drill

Dot book

Pens and pencils

Instrument accessories (sticks, reeds, oil, grease, etc.)

Guidelines

2. No student is permitted to leave the school during camp hours.
3. Do not bring valuables or large amounts of cash.
